UPDATE: GOLF BAN OFFICIALLY LIFTED

Dear Members,

During the President's address to the Nation today we all took a breath of relief as the ban of golf was officially lifted.

While the thought of opening our doors again is extremely exciting, we must stress that there are still important guidelines in place which need to be adhered to by all.

Please note that with less than 24 hours to prepare for the opening, there is also essential course maintenance which needs to take place. Tomorrow will be a slightly later start than usual. Tee times will be available from 09:00 onwards, strictly one tee start only.

Requests for tee times will not be taken by myself. Please make use of the <u>golf booking line</u> – 096 687 4746.

We have also added WhatsApp functionality to this line for your convenience. This will be operational from 08h00 to 18h00. Carts are no doubt in high demand right now based on the guidelines below, <u>booking will be essential.</u>

Please take note of the following guidelines which must be followed at all times:

- <u>Access to Bonanza:</u> please note that the temperature of everyone who enters Bonanza is being taken at the main gate, this applies to all golfers too. Please factor in a few extra minutes for this procedure in order to be on time. You will also be required to sanitize your hands at the main gate.
- Caddies will not be allowed to be used until further notice, however we will be allowing spotters who are only to search for balls and give lines on the greens. They will not be allowed to carry bags, pass clubs or clean golf balls (no contact with any equipment or the player).
- The bar is closed and no alcohol will be served (this applies at the pro shop as well). Takeaway pizza and beverages will be served.
- **PLEASE NOTE**, under no circumstance may players bring their own food or drink to the facility. This could be misconstrued by the Health Ministry should they visit us and have serious ramifications.

- Limited tables and chairs have placed around the clubhouse and spaced to encourage social distancing.
- We have decided to remove all rakes from bunkers. When a player's ball lies in a bunker, the player may take free relief by placing the original ball or another ball and playing from the relief area. *Reference Point: Spot of the original ball. Size of the Relief Area: One club length but must not be closer to the hole and must remain in the bunker.*

We will continue to keep you updated on the current situation.
